Part 1: Evaluation of the Effectiveness

1. Evaluation of achievement of the objectives: (e.g. reading culture of the whole school, students' reading attitude, book borrowing situation and students' engagement in reading activities)

The reading atmosphere of the whole school has improved. The number of borrowing books from library in the year 20-21 increased 210% comparing with 19-20. (128 books in 19-20 / 269 books in 20-21). Students were eager to participate in the reading-related activities e.g. Bookmark Design Competition and Slogan Writing Competition.

2. Evaluation of strategies: (e.g. implementing diversified and motivating activities to promote reading, reading across the curriculum and home school co-operation)

Based on the book borrowing records, students are found more interested in reading books than reading newspapers. Therefore, more books will be purchased and newspapers will not be subscribed this year. Different themes/genres of books will be purchased to promote reading across the curriculum.
